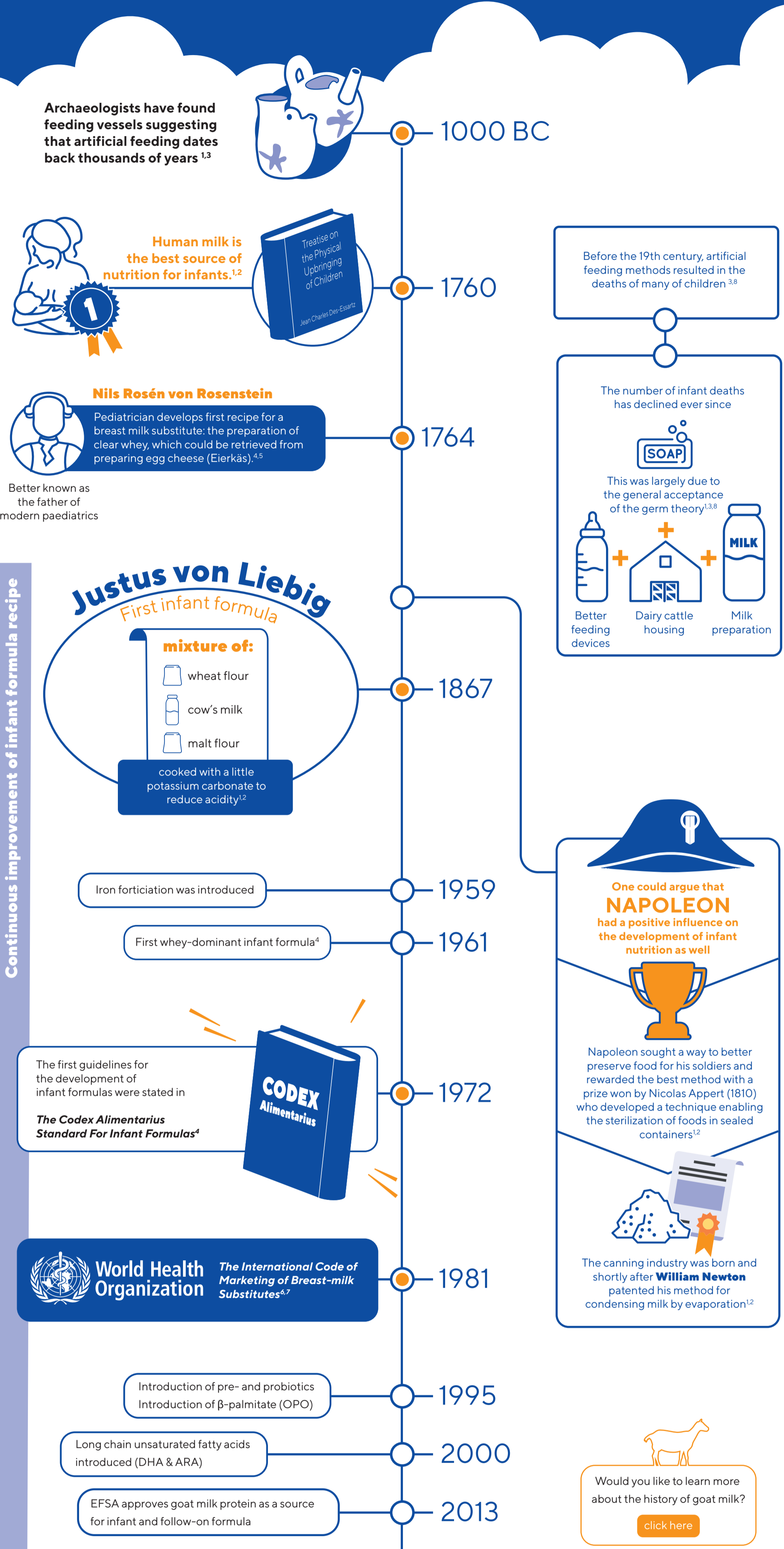


History of Infant Formula
